Celebrating R.E Week

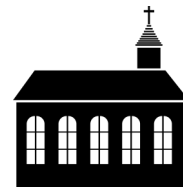
For our collective worship on Monday, we talked about the importance of having tolerance of other faiths and religions again ensuring that we are celebrating the unity in the diversity of our world.
