Children from Y5 and Y4 have taken part in two Maths competitions this week with other schools. Our team for the Mayor of London's annual Count on Us challenge (Miki and Marley from Y5 and JC from Y4) came first in their heat of 18 schools and have sailed through to the semi-final in June. Miki, Marley, Darcey and Rami from Y5 also took part in a competition with 75 schools, organised by Christ's Hospital School at the Guildhall. We had two teams of two who came joint fourth and joint 20<sup>th</sup> - another impressive result. Well done all our mathematicians!

We finished the week with our fund-raising effort for Sport Relief. We all took part in running a mile (half mile for younger children), and lots of children are collecting sponsorship money for this. We also paid £1 to wear sports clothes to school today. Please collect and bring in your sponsorship money as soon as possible so we can count our total and send the money to Sport Relief.
