Dear parents and carers,

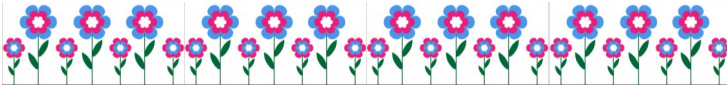
What a lovely week we have had! Thank you to all parents and carers who were able to attend parent consultations.

Next week is our last week before we break up for the Easter holidays and we hope you are looking forward to this very special time.



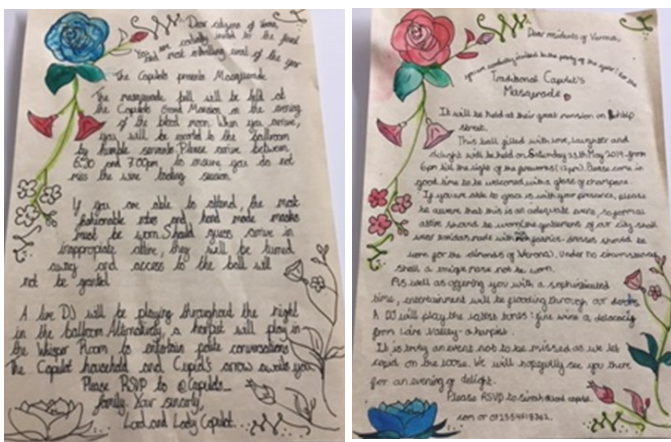
Please remember that school will finish at 2pm on Friday 5th April.
